Sharon Springs Free Library Director's Report, May 26, 2022

Meetings: There was no Director's Council this month.

There was no May MVLS Board Meeting.

There is only one remaining meeting scheduled in the old fiscal year, June 16. I have submitted my resignation from the board effective immediately after that meeting.

Programming

Miscellaneous

- Canva-designed brochure is finished and easily modified. 200 copies, \$123 with envelopes.
- Curtains and rods ordered and purchased with MVLS Furniture grant funds. \$121 Ironed and Installed by Gina.
- Gina created a spreadsheet to help create the budget for our Advocacy Funds.
- Last month, I mentioned the "Museums for All" program re: MiSci and someone asked about how widespread the program is. There are 850 museums across the country that offer free or reduced admission to anyone who produces an EBT card. A full list is available online if you search "museums for all program."

Collection Development:

- Large Print novels run about \$20 each. I have identified a list of 20 titles that are not represented well in the system. I am reviewing the titles to consider ordering.
- I have begun to look through our juvenile Non-fiction collection to weed outdated items. I will
 begin to chart areas by content to determine where we should look to fill holes or update
 content.
- I have ordered fourteen Graphic novels to develop our collection of same. Several of them are parts of series, so we will watch to see if circulation warrants buying more of the titles in the series. This order represents \$131 (rounded to the nearest dollar) from Parsons donation. (\$10,000 minus \$131 = \$9869)

Succession planning and development of procedures

There is no activity to report this month in this category.

Grant Funding

- MVLS gave us a \$500 award available for summer reading program materials. We had applied for support of SRP programs and supplies. JoAnn is keeping track of expenditures.
- Northeast Wellness and Fitness Initiative grants for "promoting wellness, nutritional and health
 information and programs" Proposal submitted 4/15 for \$5005 to support three projects; 1.
 "Come Learn with Us," an educational children's program about home grown vegetables, "Come

Grow with Us" a plan to provide anyone who comes to the food distribution (or with SNAP or EBT) with a complete set of seedlings for a summer garden, and "Come Walk with Us," a project to provide pedometers and record cards to patrons who get to keep them at the end of the summer if they have improved their number of steps. Possible plant giveaway on Saturday, May 28 or Saturday June 4 if funding is received. There is no Rotary/Food Bank distribution this month.

- Wish You Well Foundation has funding for child and adult literacy on a rolling basis.
